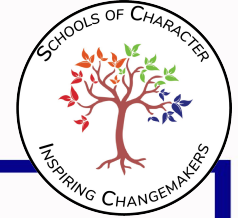

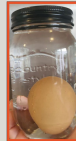

Swallows

In Swallows year 3 and 4 have been learning and exploring all about human and animals bodies. Including their bones, muscles, diets and the interesting ways the human body protects itself.

In year 5 and 6 we have been extending our understanding of living things and their habitats. We have looked at classifying animals, dissecting plants to find out how they fertilise, explore how animals have adapted to their own environments and how animals' reproduction differs from each classification.



Science at The Clinton...

In Science across the two schools we have been looking at animals including humans with Year 5/6 further developing their knowledge and understanding of living things and their habitats. The children have really enjoyed being immersed in hands on activities throughout their learning!

Kingfishers

In Kingfishers we have been learning about animals including humans. We have labelled a human body, thought about how to sort and group animals, their similarities and differences and finally looked at the types of animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and what this means.

Little Otters

We have been making 'harvest soup' this term and we have also been making sun catchers in representation of Autumn, exploring different colours and materials and gaining knowledge around seasons.
