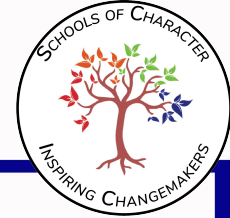


# The Clinton C of E Writing Update 25.10.24

## Swallows

In Swallows Class, we have been looking at non-chronological reports. We have really enjoyed studying a report about stone age animals. We have been learning to use adverbials and a range of pronouns, and we have assessed the appropriateness of different vocabulary. We are really excited to start writing our own reports after half term!
