


In **Swallows Class** this half term, Year 3 and 4 have been learning about mass and capacity, adding and subtracting fractions, and we will be starting a unit on time. Children have used their critical thinking to begin understanding how different elements of maths are linked and how their knowledge is transferable.

In Year 5 and 6, the children have been learning about the link between fractions, decimals and percentages, and are currently immersed in a unit on shape where they have been learning about angles, measuring angles and the relationship between angles and different shapes.

Maths at The Clinton...

In maths this half term, the children across the school have been learning a range of different mathematical skills and concepts, reflecting on their learning so far and being critical thinkers in order to find answers to various problems or questions.



In **Kingfishers Class** this half term, our Key Stage One children began by learning about statistics in the way of using tally marks and charts, drawing pictograms and interpreting information from a wide range of tables and charts. They then moved on to focusing on using and calculating with money, both notes and coins.

In **EYFS** the children have been working on their maths mastery. This has included focusing on counting, ordinality and cardinality as well as subitising and number composition.

Little Otters

In Little Otters this half term, the children have been learning about shapes, position and direction and Number 4. Little Otters have enjoyed learning the names of shapes and being eager explorers and finding shapes around our environment. Little Otters have explored some new position words such as 'on top, next to, inside, under and in between'. Little Otters will be learning about Number 4 in the last week of term.
